GRADING

*Students must meet ALL of the requirements to receive full credit in each category

Daily Participation: (25%)

- Grade components (applicable to in school and after school rehearsals):
 - o On time
 - O Prepared with the aforementioned materials
 - O Following all school rules (this includes not using a cell phone)
 - O Actively participating in rehearsal
- Marching Band Specific:
 - O All members must wear sneakers during every band rehearsal

Students who are absent from school will be exempt from the daily participation grade on that day.

There are no makeup points available for the daily participation grade.

Performance Attendance/Participation: (40%)

- Performances include all football games, competitions, parades, art gallery performances and formal concerts (see calendar list in the handbook).
- Students need to wear the specified uniform for each event.
- Marching Band Specific
 - O Unless given special permission, students may not eat in the stands (aside from the third-quarter snack).
 - O Water is the only drink we will have while wearing a uniform.
 - O All members need to be facing the field and ready to play/cheer on quick notice. Aside from the third-quarter snack, we will always stand up so that we are ready to play.
 - O Following the third-quarter snack, everyone needs to be in the stands and ready to play with 3 minutes left in the third quarter.

Assessments/Assignments: (30%)

- This category includes homework assignments, playing quizzes, written quizzes and in-class assignments.
- Playing quizzes will be due by 8 a.m. every Monday (aside from school Holidays) via Google classroom. These assignments will ONLY be accepted if they are submitted via Google classroom. Students who do not have internet access at home are welcome to make their recordings in school by setting up a time with Ms. Light.
 - o This will provide the students with weekly practice goals and frequent individualized feedback.

Final Exam: (5%)

• Will consist of rehearsal during the final exam block and performance at graduation.

MUSIC DEPARTMENT EXPECTATIONS

Performance Etiquette:

- Out of respect for each ensemble, all students are required to attend the ENTIRE performance (this applies to football games, concerts, etc.)
- Each student must be a respectful audience member while other ensembles are performing.

Marching Band Uniform:

Whenever we are in uniform, we will all wear the uniform the same way to help create a professional look....

- The band t-shirt, shorts/pants, and **tall black socks** are ALWAYS to be worn underneath the uniform.
 - O No hooded sweatshirts or jeans may be worn underneath the uniform
 - O Anything worn underneath the uniform cannot be visible to the audience
- Marching shoes and gloves are required.
- Other than parade days, the uniforms will be kept in the marching band storage room and are to be returned immediately following every performance.
 - O Families will be responsible for paying for dry cleaning if the uniform is not turned in after the Buena Vista Christmas Parade.

Marching Band Etiquette:

- Our role is to support the football team at all times regardless of the score. We will never boo, yell at the referees, etc.
- We will take the third quarter off and enjoy a snack provided by the booster organization! If the band from the visiting team comes to our home game, we will invite them to join us. Visiting the concession stand and/or eating in the stands during the game is prohibited.
- When we see another band perform, we will be attentive and supportive. We will discuss their performance in the comfort of our own band room. At no point will anyone express a negative comment in public about another band's performance.

Competition/Travel Expectations:

- All students are required to stay for the full competition event (including the award ceremony) and ride the bus to and from all performances.
 - o In the event of a serious conflict, arrangements must be made with Ms. Light in advance.

Fundraisers:

• The Music Department will hold several fundraisers throughout the year. Students will have three options for fundraisers: complete the fundraiser as outlined, donate money, or volunteer time completing music department tasks. Whichever option the student chooses must be completed by the fundraiser deadline, or detention will be assigned the next school day. This is to ensure that everyone contributes to the ongoing success of our program.

Late Assignments/Retakes:

• Late assignments will be accepted one class period late (with points deducted). Work that is more than one class period late will NOT be accepted. If you are absent from school, your work is due the day you return to school. Retakes (if eligible) must be completed within 2 class periods of the assignment/test being returned. Students who are absent for an assessment/in class assignment will be required to make it up during the next band period.

VARSITY LETTER

- After successfully completing two years in the PMHS Band, students will earn a varsity letter:
 - Successful completion means there are not any unexcused absences and the student has maintained a 75 percent average or above for both school years.

CONCERT ATTIRE

- Aside from honor ensemble performances, concert attire will always be kept at school. Students will change at school before and after each concert.
- Families need to provide **formal black dress shoes** (closed toe) and black socks, if applicable. White undershirts need to be worn underneath the tuxedo. Straps should not be visible outside of the dresses.
- If a student damages or loses a part of his/her concert attire, their family will be responsible for replacing the items at the costs outlined below
 - O Dress (\$60), necklace (\$12)
 - O Jacket (\$55), pants (\$23), tuxedo shirt (\$15), cummerbund (\$6), bowtie (\$2)


